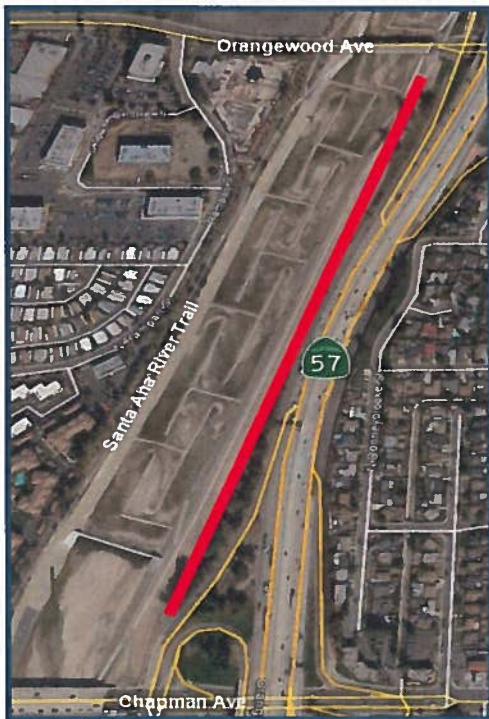
Storage of Sand/Rock Flood Protection Supplies and Installation of Maintenance Road Fencing

- WHAT:**
- 1** Use of large equipment to **grade/repair ground areas** to prepare for storage of flood protection materials (see below).
 - 2** **Storing of large rocks** (known as "rip-rap") **and sand** along the County stockpile area (sand removed from other flood control channel as part of flood protection maintenance). Materials to be stored and later used as needed for flood protection and beach replenishment throughout the county.
 - 3** **Installation of upgraded fencing** at gates and other locations along the County stockpile area.

The County maintenance road / stockpile area is for County operations only and is restricted to public access. For your safety, we urge everyone to observe all caution signs, stay a safe distance from project equipment and operations, and keep out of flood control channels and riverbeds, especially during rain storms.

WHEN: **Beginning early February 2017 and continuing through June 2017.**
Schedule is tentative and could change depending on weather or other factors.

WHERE: Along the County's maintenance road / stockpile area along the east side of the Santa Ana River, between Orangewood Ave. and the Santa Ana Freeway (5)
