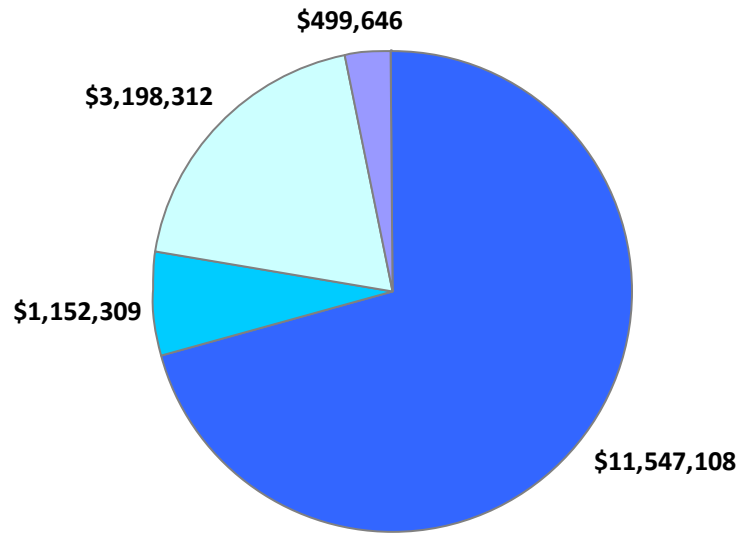
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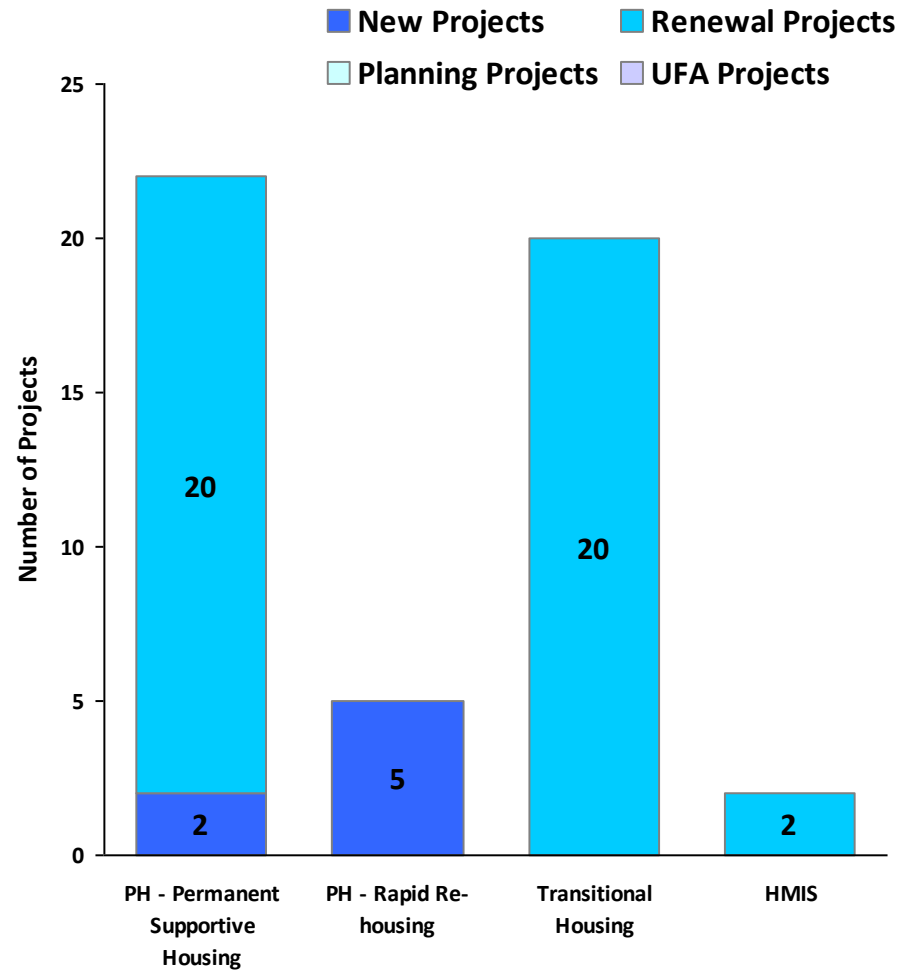

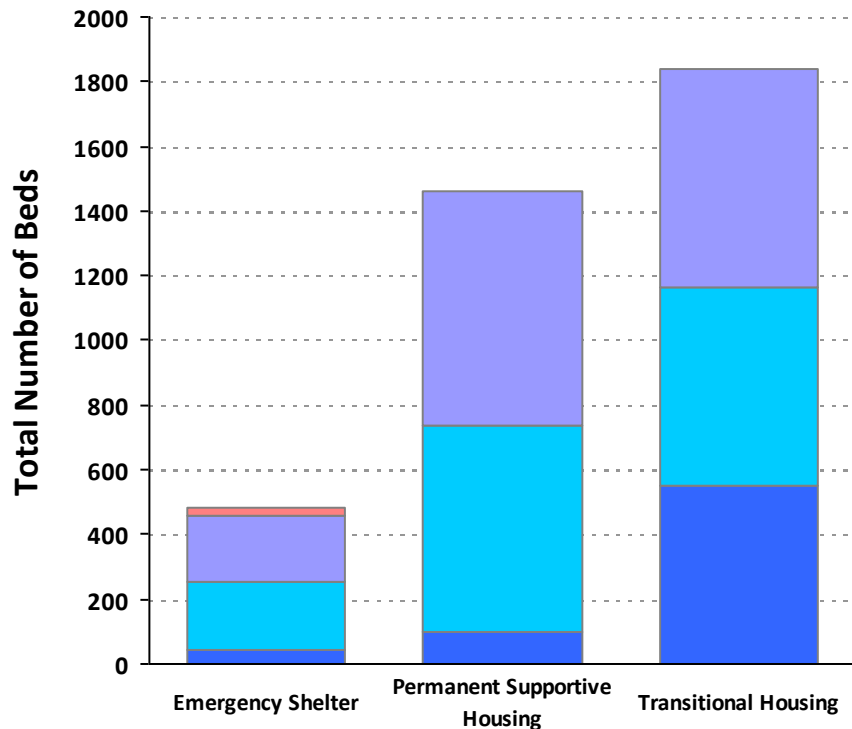

Beds by Designated Target Population

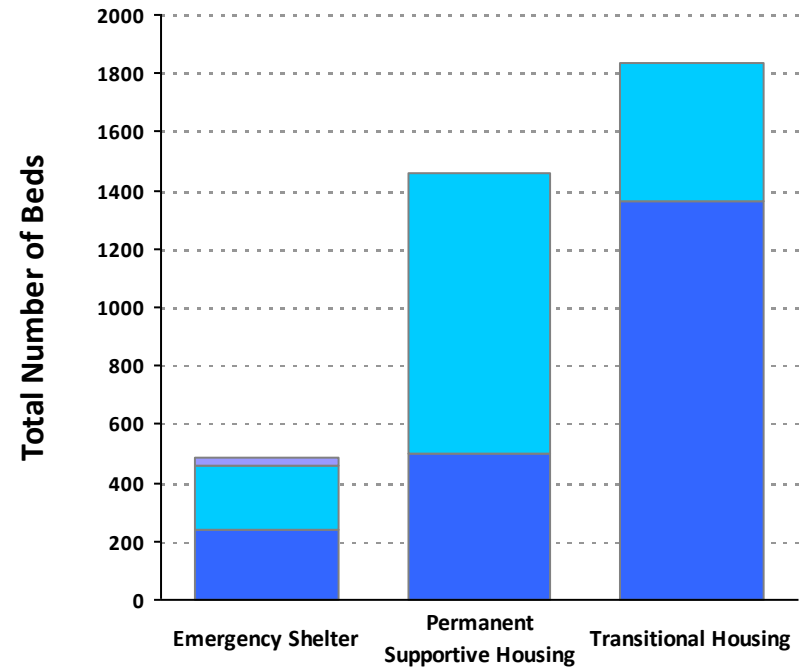

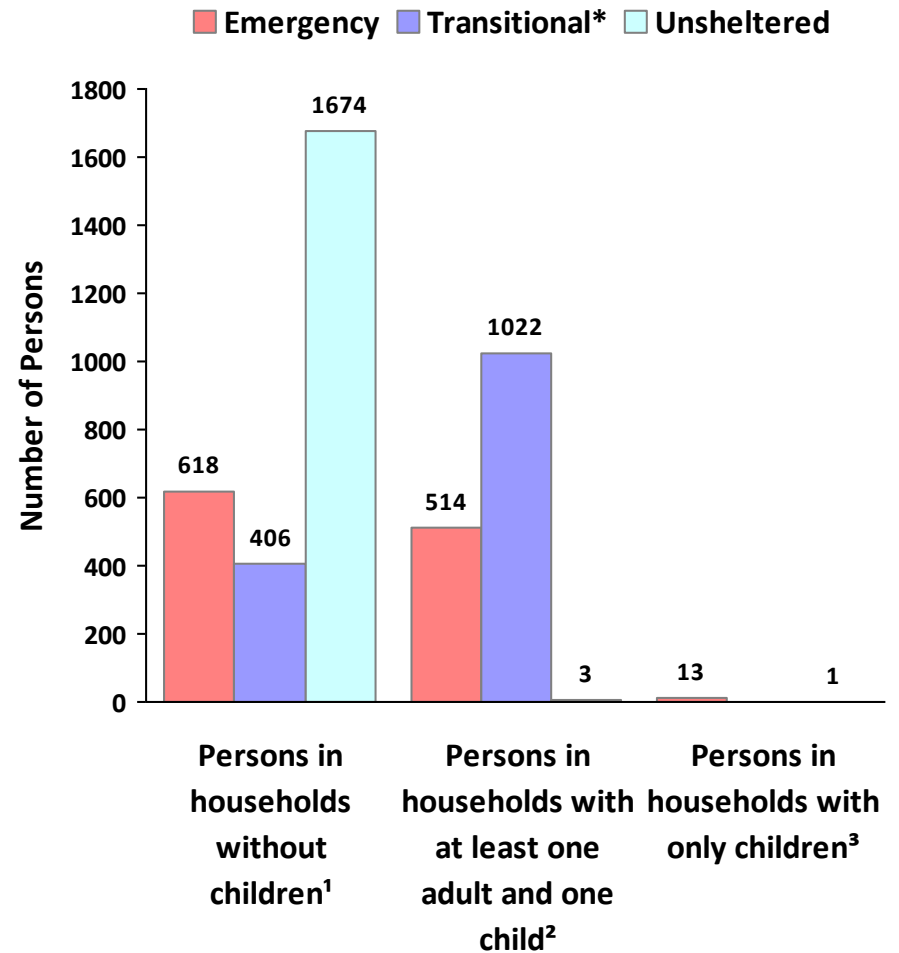
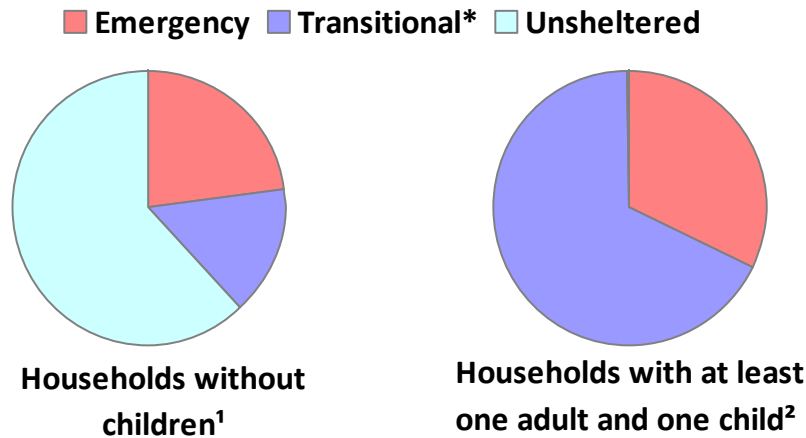
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2013 Point in Time Count Summarized by Household Type

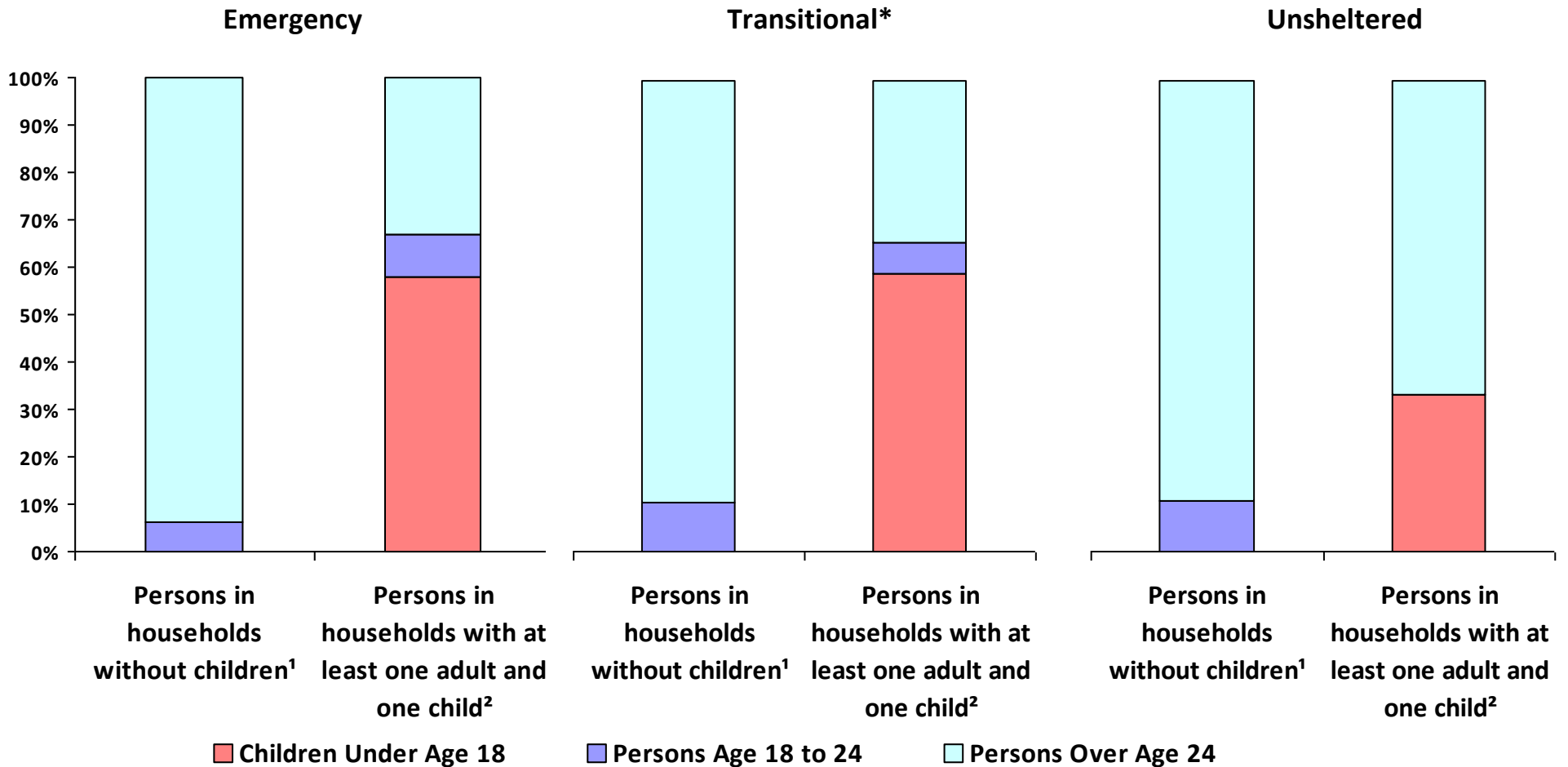


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2013 Point-In-Time Count Proportion of Persons in each Age Group by Household Type
