- Opportunities for companies to coordinate giving, in-kind support, and employee resources to strengthen community resilience

Through this network, businesses can be part of a coordinated effort alongside county leaders and disaster response partners, while 2-1-1 Orange County (211OC) serves as the trusted hub for community information and critical resources before, during, and after disasters.

What Members Receive

- Quarterly convenings with emergency management experts, including participation in a countywide tabletop exercise with public sector partners
- Tools, guidance, and timely updates to strengthen business preparedness planning
- Opportunities to align company resources with community needs during disasters

What Participation Requires

- Commit to four quarterly 90-minute meetings per year
- Designate an emergency preparedness point of contact for your business
- Identify non-sensitive company resources you can share during an emergency
- Share Orange County United Way and 211OC information, updates, and resources with employees, including during disasters
